They must certify that their products are produced without Neonics, neonicotinoids or other systemic pesticides. For landscape designers and architects, land care professionals, landscaping installers, foresters, arborists, or any other land care service provider, they must work with and actively promote the use of native plants to qualify for ONPN professional membership. For cities, educational institutions, and any other entity that does not sell natives or provide land care services, they must actively promote native plants to qualify for ONPN professional membership.

I thereby authorize the ONPN Program staff to identify and promote my native plant materials and services. I understand the right to use the ONPN logo is personal to members and may not be assigned or transferred to any other entity without prior written consent of the ONPN Program. The terms of this Agreement commence upon receipt of approval and shall continue until termination upon written notice from the ONPN Program.
